Dear Students and Parents,

As juniors and seniors (or the parents of ...) you are probably beginning to think about life after high school. There are a lot of decisions to be made and for many of you that will include college. Getting into college means evaluating your high school career and taking the SAT test.

Colleges look at:

- Difficulty level of classes
- Grade point average
- High school activities
- Class rank
- Recommendations
- SAT scores

You can get help now for the SAT. My suggestion is to plan to take the test two times. If you are a junior a good plan is to take the test in December 2010 and Fall 2011. If you are a senior and you have not yet taken the SAT you should plan to take the test in December 2010 and March or May 2011.

Why is it important to do well? Colleges consider the SAT a standard by which they evaluate students from high schools across the country. Some schools believe they can predict how well students will perform in their first year of college based on SAT scores.

Read the brochure and see if our SAT prep class is right for you. Be sure to take note of the class policy. This class requires consistent attendance. If you expect results participation needs to be a priority.

## The SAT Prep class will be offered two times during the 2010-2011 school year

### WINTER SESSION:

- Classes begin Sept 23 through Dec 2, from 6:30 to 8:00
- The test date is **DEC 4, 2010**
- There is no class on Oct 14, Nov 11 & Nov 25

### We will be covering:

Strategies for writing, improving sentences, identifying errors, improving paragraphs, strategies for math, numbers, problem solving, arithmetic, algebra, geometry, probability, critical reading, sentence completion, reading passages, vocabulary.
